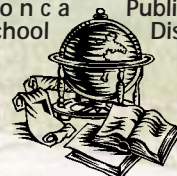

New Endowed Funds

Waldo & Joy A. Birkley Family Scholarship Endowment: \$2,000

Waldo established this scholarship in memory of his late wife Joy (Lieber) Birkley. Joy taught school and was very active in 4-H and church activities. The Birkleys have been involved in PHS over the years as all of their children and grandchildren are graduates of PHS. This new scholarship will be awarded each year to a graduating senior selected by the Foundation Scholarship Committee.

Col. Earl C. & Celia Bogard Scholarship Endowment: \$3,000

This new endowment has been established by Col. Earl C. and Celia Bogard to benefit a graduating PHS senior who plans to pursue studies in science or music. The Bogards have been very active in PHS and community projects in Ponca. The Foundations Scholarship Selection Committee will award this scholarship each year based on the criteria set forth.

Lamp Oil Grant: Anonymous Donor \$2,000

"A lamp is a symbol of learning and enlightenment gained from education and experience. Lamp oil is necessary to keep the lamp burning. This grant is given to provide a 'measure of fuel' to enable the recipient to pursue knowledge and experience. This gift may be awarded to an individual connected to the Ponca Public School district of any age who desires to grow academically, professionally, or spiritually." This year this award will be used by the Foundations Scholarship Selection Committee.

Ponca First Presbyterian Church Scholarship Endowment: \$6,000
