

Lewis & Clark Conference Athletic Directors Meeting

March 24, 2010

Revisions and Proposals to Conference Basketball Tournament

1. The top 4 seeds will host 1st round games. The #1 seed would have a bye. The #2 seed would host games between 7 vs 10 & 2 vs 15. The #3 seed would host games between 6 vs 11 & 3 vs 14. The #4 seed would host games between 5 vs 12 & 4 vs 13. The 8 seed would host the 9 seed in a single game at the site of the 8 seed. The host school will play the second game at each site. If a host school does not think they can host because of capacity or other factors they may pick an alternate site that is not being used. If a host picks a site outside of the conference, fees for rental and other expenses will be paid by the host unless given permission by the conference president.
2. Move the boy's semifinals to Saturday of week 31 at one site and leave the girls semifinal on Friday of week 31, but play at one site. This would eliminate the problem of girls and boys teams from the same school playing at different sites during the semifinals. It could also generate more revenue for the tournament.
3. Seed the consolation round according to closest losing seed. (Example 15th seed vs 14th seed.) The tournament directors will determine consolation bracket after 1st round games are completed. The lowest remaining losing seed after the 1st round does not play in the consolation round.
4. Consolation rounds will be played at one site beginning at 5:30pm. Only sites with 2 gymnasiums will serve as host sites for the consolation round. The teams playing in the second and third games of the consolation will warm-up in the auxiliary gym. Teams must be given at least 5 minutes warm-up in the main gym.
5. Consolation sties
2010-2011 Girls: Wakefield/Boys: Homer

2011-2012 Girls: Ponca/Boys: Winnebago

2012-2013 Girls: Bloomfield/Boys: Wakefield

2013-2014 Girls: Homer/Boys: Ponca

2014-2015 Girls: Winnebago/Boys: Bloomfield.
6. Allen would be added to the gym rotation on the Clark side. Allen would follow Winside in the girls rotation and follow Wausa in the boys rotation.
7. Raise the admission price for the conference tournament from \$4 adult & \$3 student to \$4 adult & \$4 student.
8. Change the mileage reimbursement. Either eliminate mileage reimbursement completely or pay mileage after the 1st round games.
9. The conference could make produce the programs for the tournament. The conference secretary would make a template that will put on the conference website. Each host school could run off 11 X 17 programs for games at their site. Programs cost approximately \$850. Reimburse the conference secretary \$100 for organizing and producing the template. Could also be done for the conference volleyball tournament.
10. With the above changes it is estimated the conference could save approximately \$3000

Other items discussed:

1. Recommend charging admission for conference events such as one act, speech, vocal music concert, and instrumental music concert,
2. Recommend the divisions remain as is with no changes for 2010-2011, note Coleridge needs to be dropped from divisions.
3. No changes for volleyball, track, or golf.
