Information from Joan M. Reznicek, Superintendent of Schools

As we continue with the second semester, it is the most important time of the school year with our students in the majority of grade levels taking numerous tests ranging from the Nebraska State Accountability (NeSA) tests for writing, reading, math, and science. Plus, selected grades of students will also take the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP) tests. The eighth graders have already completed the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) test. During the spring semester from the end of January to the beginning of May, the academic progress of our students is measured. These are the tests scores we will read about next fall in the major State Newspapers.

All of the tests mentioned in the above paragraph are extremely important for our school district because <u>many of the tests are also connected to Federal and State dollars (resources) for our school district</u>. As a school district, we must have our students take every test with extreme high expectations. Every student should strive to do their best because it reflects their learning process at Ponca Public Schools.

As parents, please be sure that your child is getting at least 9 hours of sleep plus eating breakfast prior to coming to school prepared for the day. With the annual tests that a school district takes, it is the responsibility of both the school and the parents.

Just as a reminder, if school is dismissed due to the weather, those days may have to be completed at the end of the year.



NOTICE TO PARENTS OF PONCA SCHOOL PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENTS WHO MAY BE CONSIDERING ENROLLMENT OPTIONS FOR THE 2013 – 2014 SCHOOL YEAR

Parents or guardians considering the use of the enrollment options program to enroll their child/ren in another public school district in the state of Nebraska should be aware of the following date:

March 15, 2013. Deadling for filing enrollment option application for the 2013-2014 school year unless a

March 15, 2013 - Deadline for filing enrollment option application for the 2013-2014 school year unless a waiver of dates is granted.

Limitation - The enrollment option shall be available only once to each student prior to graduation unless:

- (a) the student relocates in a different resident school district,
- (b) the option school district merges with another district.

Eligibility – Eligibility will be considered for transfer students who have transferred from one school to another when there is not a change of domicile by the parents. Those students who have their transfer papers signed and filed on or before March 15 shall be eligible immediately in the fall. Those students who do not have their transfer applications signed and filed on or before March 15 shall be ineligible for 90 school days.

Transportation – The parents of the optioned student shall be responsible for required transportation to the option district.
