## **Edit Google Drive documents offline**

Using Google Drive, you can read and edit your saved Google Docs, Sheets, Slides, and Drawings documents when you're offline.

## Turn on Google Drive offline

To save your Google Drive documents for offline use:

- 1. If you haven't already, sign in to your Chromebook.
- 2. Make sure that your Chromebook is connected to the web.
- 3. Open Chrome 🧐.
- 4. Go to <u>drive.google.com</u>.
- 5. In the upper right corner, click the settings icon  $\Rightarrow$  > Settings.
- 6. In the "Offline" area, check the box for Sync Google Docs, Sheets, Slides & Drawings files to this computer so that you can edit offline.
- 7. Click Done.
- 8. Wait for a few minutes. Your Chromebook will automatically save your Google Drive documents so you can read or edit them when you're offline. If you have a lot of files, you might see a message that your files are syncing.

## **Turn off Google Drive offline**

To turn off Google Drive offline and remove the synced files from your Chromebook:

- 1. If you haven't already, sign in to your Chromebook.
- 2. Make sure that your Chromebook is connected to the web.
- 3. Open Chrome 🧐.
- 4. Go to <u>drive.google.com</u>.
- 5. In the upper right corner, click the settings icon  $\Rightarrow$  > Settings.
- 6. In the "Offline" area, uncheck the box.
- 7. Click Done.
