Southeast Community College Walter Scott, Jr. Career Pathway Scholarship

The Walter Scott, Jr. Career Pathway Scholarship Program provides recipients with up to four consecutive semesters of full tuition and fees, plus room and board, a Scott Pathway Director to assist with career development (at the Hastings campus), and additional enrichment opportunities to support learning and career development outside the classroom. Chadron State College RHOP

Chadron State College Rural Health Opportunities Program (RHOP) is a collaboration with Chadron State College and the University of Nebraska Medical Center. The purpose of the program is to recruit and educate high school students from rural Nebraska who will return to practice in rural areas of the state. Each recipient will receive an RHOP Tuition waiver for a maximum of 16 hours of credit per semester for each year they attend Chadron State College and guaranteed admission to UNMC upon satisfactory completion of all requirements within the deadline. J.H. and J.W Claybaugh Memorial Scholarship

Nebraska residents, those attending school in Nebraska, or those interested in a career in poultry based in Nebraska are encouraged to apply for one of two \$2,500 J.H. & J.W. Claybaugh Memorial Scholarships. Applicants must be incoming college freshman or post-grad students. In addition to the application, your high school transcript is required. Winners are required to attend the Nebraska Poultry Industries Conference on March 7, 2024. The application is available here. Applications are due December 15, 2023.

Nebraska Poultry Education Scholarship

Nebraska residents, those attending school in Nebraska, or those interested in a career in poultry based in Nebraska are encouraged to apply for the 2024-2025 Nebraska Poultry Education Scholarship. A total of eight \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for the 2024-2025 academic year. Scholarships are awarded based on college credit hours completed. Briar Cliff University Presidential Scholarship

The BCU Presidential Scholarship is a full tuition scholarship that will cover all four years (or eight semesters) a student is enrolled at Briar Cliff. Each year, the scholarship is awarded to four incoming, undergraduate students who have exemplified academic excellence, outstanding contributions to their community, and extraordinary leadership thus far in their education careers. A student must have a GPA of 3.75 or above, complete a scholarship application, submit two letters of recommendation, a resume displaying academic effort, leadership experience, and volunteerism, and a short video answering a few questions. Students may also be invited for an interview. Four additional "Gold" scholarships will be awarded following the interviews, each valued at \$10,000/year as well as four "Blue" scholarships worth \$5,000/year. All students who interview will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. The application is available here. The Fall application deadline is October 16, 2023 with interviews taking place on October 27, 2023. The Spring application deadline is January 15, 2024 with interviews taking place on January 26, 2024.
