Good Life Great Journey Scholarship Program

This scholarship application is open to individuals interested in a career in the following hard-to-fill positions with the Nebraska Department of Transportation (NDOT): Diesel Technology, Electronics Systems/Electrical Technology, Land Surveying/GIS/Civil Engineering Technology, Drafting/Design Technology, Engineering, and Information Technology. Benefits include up to 100% paid tuition, books, fees, and tools, housing expense, travel reimbursement, paid internship, and employment opportunities upon program completion. James M. Cox Foundation Scholarship

This \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a high school graduate planning to attend a Nebraska-based institution of higher learning who demonstrates financial need in order to pursue further education. The Foundation awards the scholarship on the basis of need, giving special consideration to low income situations. Other factors, obstacles, or extenuating circumstances (medical expenses, death or disability of a parent, etc.) are also considered. Application requirements include the application, FAFSA, official transcript, two letters of recommendation and an essay. Applications are available in the Guidance Office. Application deadline is April 15, 2024.

Michael Foods Shaping Future Leaders Scholarship

Any 2024 graduating senior who is currently working for Michael Foods, Inc. is eligible to apply for this \$1,000 scholarship. Consideration will be based on academic stability (at least a 2.5 GPA), extracurricular participation, and community and work activities. Applications can be picked up from your supervisor or at the main plant front desk. Application deadline is April 26, 2024.

Northeast Community College Theater Scholarship

Theater majors can receive one of four available 75% tuition waivers. Theater participants can receive a 25% tuition waiver. The scholarship application form (available in the Guidance Office) must be completed and the applicant must contact the theater program's director to arrange an audition by April 30, 2024.
