OACCW College Scholarship

The Omaha Archdiocesan Council of Catholic Women (OACCW) will offer a \$750 scholarship to a female high school senior in the Archdiocese of Omaha. Each Deanery will select from the applications received and the winner at this level will receive a \$300 scholarship. Their name will then be submitted for consideration of the \$750 OACCW scholarship. Doane University Scholarships

Nebraska Press Association Foundation Scholarship

Nebraska Society of Professional Engineers (NeSPE) Scholarships

The Nebraska Society of Professional Engineers is offering several scholarships for high school seniors that plan on attending an engineering program next year. The following scholarships are offered: State Annual Scholarship (In-state only) - \$1,500, two available; Northeast Chapter Annual Scholarship (School of your choice) - \$1,000, one available; Eastern Chapter Annual Scholarship (In-state only) - \$1,000, two available. The NeSPE scholarship application qualifies as an application for both the state and local Northeastern Nebraska Chapter scholarships. Bill Lewis Scholarship
