#### **Heisman High School Scholarship**

The Heisman Trophy Trust is proud to reward community-minded scholar athletes at the state and national level. 100 state winners will receive a \$1,000 scholarship. Ten national finalists will receive a \$2,000 scholarship. Two national winners will receive a \$10,000 scholarship. Requirements include maintaining a GPA of 3.0 or higher, participation in at least one sport, and involvement in volunteer service and leadership at school or in the community. #### **Coca Cola Scholars Program**

The Coca-Cola Scholars Program Scholarship is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. 150 scholars are selected each year to receive this \$20,000 scholarship. Applicants must be U.S. citizens who are current high school seniors. #### **Nebraska Softball Foundation (NSF) Scholarship**

This scholarship was created to award funds to Nebraska ASA members who desire to continue their education. The number and value of scholarships awarded each year will be determined by the NSF Scholarship Committee. Criteria include: scholarship must be used in a post-secondary or 4-year institution; must be a member of the USA Softball of Nebraska; minimum 3.0 GPA; official high school transcript; resume; three letters of recommendation; short essay indicating the reasons why you feel you should be considered for this scholarship. This \$1,000 scholarship (administered by the Nebraska Softball Scholarship Program) is offered to anyone who is a registered official or a family member of a registered official. Requirements are the same as the NSF Scholarship (above). ## **Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student (MVS) Scholarship**

The National Elks Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships ranging from \$1,000 - \$12,500 per year to the highest rated applicants in the 2022 competition. Eligible applicants must be high school seniors pursuing a four-year degree. Applications will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. ## **Wayne State College Career Scholars Cooperative Education Scholarship**

The Career Scholars Cooperative Education Program is an accelerated curriculum program. During your first three years on campus at WSC you'll have the opportunity to participate in site visits, job shadowing, and mentorships. During your senior year, you'll move to Norfolk, Grand Island, or Columbus, where you will earn 18 credit hours by working for a business for approximately 30 hours per week. The total scholarship package, valued at around \$24,000, is broken down as follows: Freshman - \$2,500; Sophomore - \$3,000; Junior - \$3,500; Senior- \$5,000 for tuition plus \$10,000 for housing. The purpose of the program is to recruit and educate high school students from rural Nebraska who will return to practice in rural areas of the state. Each recipient will receive an RHOP Tuition waiver for a maximum of 16 hours of credit per semester for each year they attend Chadron State College and guaranteed admission to UNMC upon satisfactory completion of all requirements within the deadline. ## **NROTC Scholarship**

The purpose of the Naval Reserve Officer Training Corps Program is to educate and train qualified young men and women for service as commissioned officers in the Navy's unrestricted line, the Navy Nurse Corps, and the Marine Corps. This scholarship provides up to \$180,000 toward achieving a bachelor's degree at the university of their choice and eventually receive a federal commission as a Second Lieutenant. Eligible students must have a minimum ACT score of 22 or a minimum ASVAB score of 74, must be a U.S. citizen, and be in good physical condition.
