#### **Olin E. Teague Scholarship**

The National Space Club and Foundation offers a scholarship each year in memory of the Honorable Olin E. Teague, a Representative in Congress who aggressively supported our national space program, to encourage talented young people to pursue careers in aerospace fields. The scholarship, in the amount of \$4,000.00, is awarded to a graduating high school senior at an accredited U.S. high school. The student must be a U.S. Citizen. #### **Coca Cola Scholars Program**

The Coca-Cola Scholars Program Scholarship is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. 150 scholars are selected each year to receive this \$20,000 scholarship. Applicants must be U.S. citizens who are current high school seniors. #### **Nebraska Softball Foundation (NSF) Scholarship**

This scholarship was created to award funds to Nebraska ASA members who desire to continue their education. The number and value of scholarships awarded each year will be determined by the NSF Scholarship Committee. Criteria include: scholarship must be used in a post-secondary or 4-year institution; must be a member of the USA Softball of Nebraska; minimum 3.0 GPA; official high school transcript; resume; three letters of recommendation; short essay indicating the reasons why you feel you should be considered for this scholarship.
